Plane prayers

Suitable for: Everyone (but it works particularly well for primary school boys)

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Essentials:

Paper

Pens

Instruction card (enclosed)

Give each child a piece of paper onto which they can write or draw their prayer.

Show them how to fold their paper into a plane (the teachers will love you for this).

When a child has finished their prayer plane, they can take it to the designated launch place and throw it as a physical, practical AMEN to their prayer.



Write or draw what you want to pray about on a piece of paper.

When you have finished, use the paper to make a paper plane.

Hold your plane and think about what you are asking God to do and launch your plane as a way of saying AMEN!
